Warren was established in 1843 but was not incorporated until 1857 and today is a town of 1428 citizens. Warren is located in Jo Daviess County on Scenic Stagecoach Trail and State Highway 78. Warren is approximately 1 mile from the Wisconsin border. The County Seat of Jo Daviess County is Galena.
